**TWILIGHT FORMAT & ABBREVIATED RULES - FULL RULES AVAILABLE ON THE QTC WEBSITE**

Rounds - start 5.15 (sharp) and 6.45pm. Warm ups should be concluded by 5.15pm.

Teams to supply their own good quality tennis balls. Take it in turns.

Matches are best of 3 sets. First two are normal sets to 6 (7 point tie-break at 6-6).

Third set (if required) is a super tie-break to 10 points (two points clear, eg 10-8, 11-9, 18-16)

Results to be recorded online via the website after your game

If your partner is unavailable use the reserves, bye players that week or other players within your grade.

Please refer to Rule 2.1 in the Twilight Rules on the website.

If you cannot play your match at the allocated time due to rain or other commitments it is your responsibility to arrange arrange with the opposition another time. Courts maybe be booked using the Pay2 Play system on night other than Twilight

If a team fails to turn up for a match or cancels on the match day, the opposition may claim a default, and 4 points, at their discretion. The opposition can choose to replay depending on the circumstances.

The committee **STRONGLY** advises that you play matches using reserves or other available players, rather than postpone, as per Rule 2.1. Experience shows that many matches never get played otherwise.

To play twilight you must be a full member of Queenstown Tennis Club

Teams will play each other at least once in the season. For this season, we are also introducing

play-offs, which will be played over the last two or three Post-Christmas rounds. All teams will be eligible to play in the play-offs, as long as they have played with their listed partner at least 50% of matches, and play with the listed partner in the play-offs

Points system

4 points - Win 2 straight sets

3 points - Win 2 sets to 1 set

2 points - 1 set only

1 point - for a straight sets loss

0 points - for a no show, or match day cancellation

**Note: If the match does not get played for whatever reason, neither team gets any points. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
