Twilight Format & Abbreviated Rules - Full Rules Available on the QTC Website

Games to Start at 5-15 & 6-45 Sharp. Warm Ups to be Concluded by 5-15pm

Teams to provide their own good quality match balls

Matches are Best of 3 Sets. The First Two Sets are played to the normal Tie Break Score of First to 7, if the Set Score is 6-6

If a Third Set is Required, Play A Super Tie Break of First to 10

Like in all Tie-Break Situations there should be at least 2 Points between the teams 7-5, 9-7, 10-8, 12-10 etc

Please Record Your Score in the Whatsapp Chat created for your Match.

If your partner is unavailable, please look at the reserves or a team who has a Bye for available replacements. Reserve Players Must be from Your Grade

If you are unable to play your match, it is your responsibility to find a replacement, notify your partner and/or opponents or rearrange your match for a different time

Please refer to the website for full Twilight Rules

Courts Can be booked using the Pay2Play system

If a team fails to turn up for a match or cancels on match day, the opposition may claim a default and 4 points at their discretion. The opposition can choose to rearrange the match depending on the circumstances

The committee STRONGLY advises that you play matches using reserves or available players rather than postpone, as experience shows matches are otherwise forfeited and never played

To be eligible to play Twilight you must be a Full Paying member of Queenstown Tennis Club

Teams will play each other at least once, and this season we are introducing a Play-off at the end of the season. To be eligible for the Playoffs your team must have played at least Half their scheduled matches and play with your listed partner
